

Transportation Thresholds

Achieve strictest of federal, state, or regional standards for carbon monoxide, ozone, and particulates; increase visibility; reduce U.S. 50 traffic; and reduce vehicle miles traveled.

Return to 1960 water levels by reducing nutrient and sediment runoff.

2045.




How do people travel at Tahoe today?






ESTIMATED TRIP DISTRIBUTION BY TRAVELER (2018)






ESTIMATED TRIP DISTRIBUTION BY TRIP TYPE (2018)




Current Mode Split












Active Transportation Trips





BICYCLE VS. E-BIKE USE 2020 - 2023



Seasonal Transit Ridership




