Budget Update

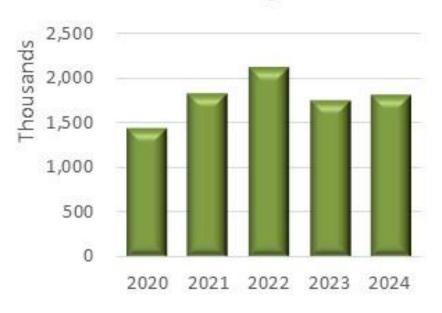
- California
 - May revision completed; deficit to continue;
 - Continue to work with state on staff salary adjustment match
- Nevada
 - Staff salary adjustment item pushed to June 14th Board of Examiners meeting
 - Biennium covering July 2025 June 2027



Highlights

- Revenue at 65% of budget
 - Planning fees ahead of prior year
 - Shoreline and AIS fees ~2/3 of budget
 - Grant revenue ramping
- Expenditures at 56% of budget
 - Comp at 78%
 - Contracts ramping; up to 41%
 - Debt interest payment due in June

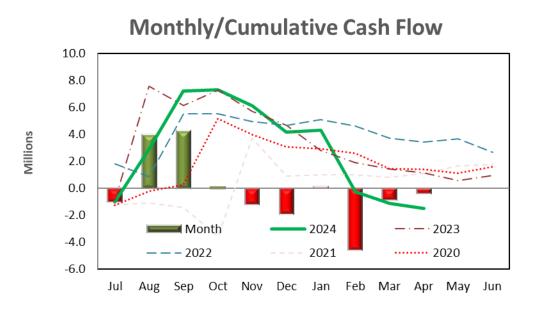

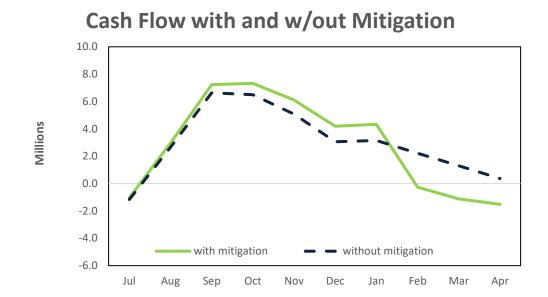

Overall, \$2.5M increase in projected Revenue

- General Fund increase \$1.6M, primarily from investment interest income, planning fees, and both states salary increases.
- Continuing to work toward planning cost recovery
- Grants up \$1.0M driven by LTRA, Infrastructure funds, and AIS fee increase
- Bottom line is balanced including building fund



Highlights

- Funds the work plan
- Ops manager workshop & input into the budget
- Balanced by closing the gap with operating team and efficiencies

Enables

- Investments in talent ... prioritizing staff
- Empowerment of staff driving mission critical work



Key Revenue Assumptions

- State funding assumptions:
 - Nevada \$430K for AB522 for salary increases
 - \$134K match needed from California for salary increases
- Increase in planning fees
 - 6% inflation adjustment plus current run rate for expedite premiums
 - Major projects in planning phase
 - Leading indicators trending upward through May
- Increase interest income



Key Expenditure Assumptions

- Agency at full staff
- 3-5% merit-based salary increase for staff; critical for long term health
- Zero-based contracts estimates
