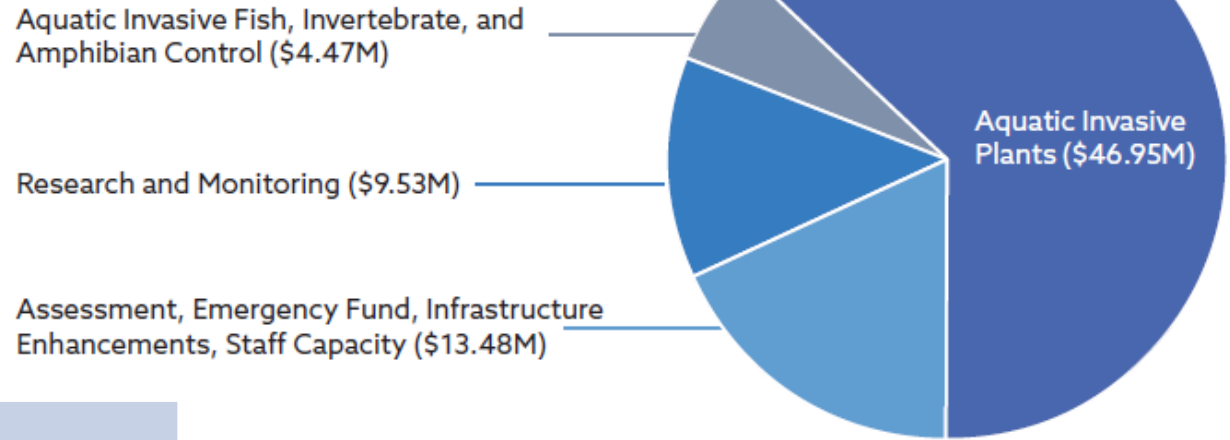

 Invasive species risk assessment completed	 <b>AQUATIC INVASIVE INVERTEBRATES</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reductions of signal crayfish and mysid shrimp in designated regions of Lake Tahoe</li> </ul>
 Funds expended per unit	 <b>INVASIVE AMPHIBIANS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reductions of bullfrogs in designated regions of Lake Tahoe</li> </ul>

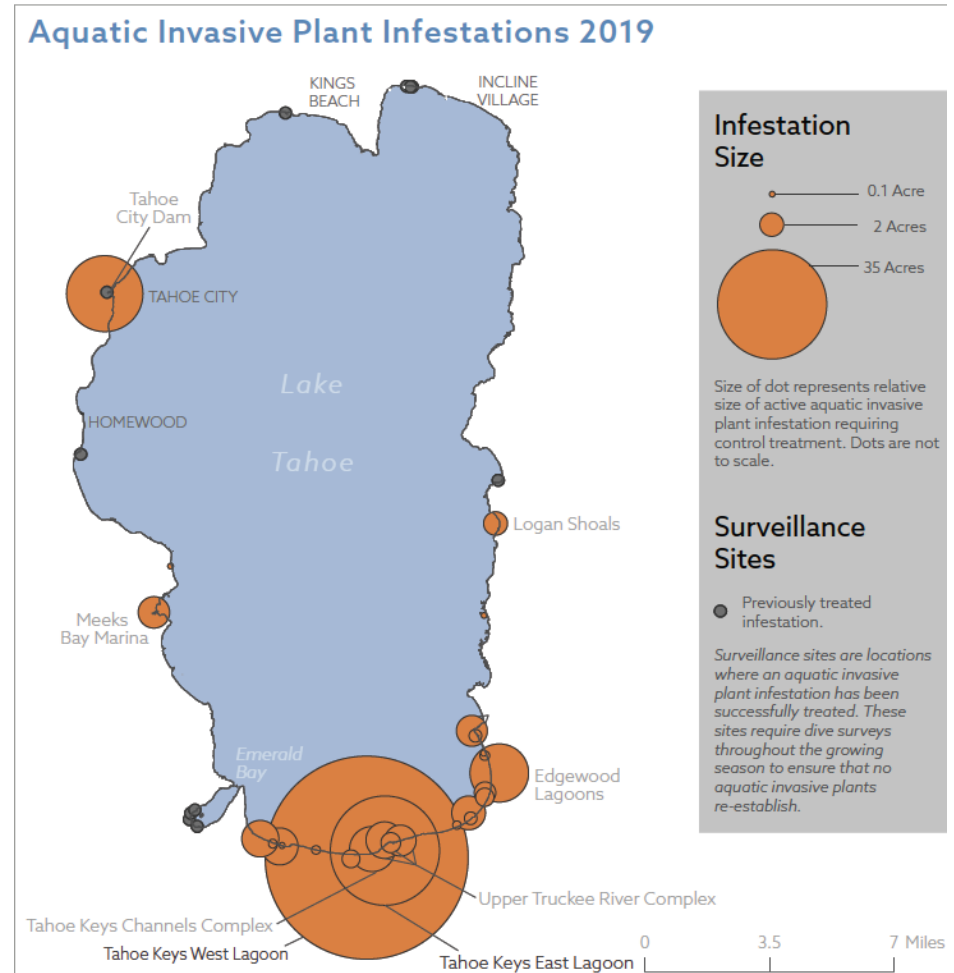
