

Transit Coordination


At Lake Tahoe, "Transit" is a collection of public and private vehicles operating as a system that requires coordinated planning and operations

TRPA's Transit Accountability:

- POLICY
 - Reduce Auto use policy, develop an RTP with specific transit policies TRPA Compact
- FUNDING
 - Administer funding and analyze productivity and efficiency then make operational recommendations - Transportation Development Act & Federal MPO
- TARGETS and THRESHOLDS
 - Collect data, create projects and programs in the RTP that meet our GHG reduction targets, maintain Thresholds - State Regional Transportation Planning CA/MPO, Compact

Operated by public or private


No CDL required if private
